## Title Coffee Cup

Date mid 1930s

Primary Maker Lenox, Inc.

Medium Mold-formed, porcelain with gilding and overglaze brown enamel decoration

Description Wide, cylindrical, ivory, porcelain coffee cup with gilding and overglaze brown enamel. The coffee cup has a flat bottom surface and vertical sides, with an angular handle. Thick bands of gilding have been applied to the handle, rim, and foot, and in a rectangle surrounding the printed decoration on the coffee cup. Opposite the handle, a scene titled, "STATE HOUSE . MAIN STREET" then, "HARTFORD CONN" has been applied using a halftone printing process. The scene shows the State House on the left as a three-story building with a cupola and flag flying above. In the middle of the scene is Main Street,
