Medium Mechanically-molded porcelain with gilding and polychrome enamels

Description Small, round, porcelain plate with an undulating rim. The plate is

decorated with gilding and both transfer-printed and hand-painted enamels.

The circular pattern in the center of the plate is printed with black enamel, then

hand-colored with blue, green, peach, brown, and grey enamels. The pattern

shows a road crossing a body of water in the foreground. The road leads below a

pointed arch supported on either side of the road by two circular towers. The

road and monument are located in a park with many trees. A multi-story building with an irregular roofline and circular, domed cupula is visible beyond the park on the right. Near the bottom of the pattern is the title, "CAPITOL AND SOLDIERS & SAILORS MEMORIAL ARCH, HARTFORD, CONN." The pattern is surrounded by a gilt filigree border, then six groups of impressionistic handpainted pink, blue, and green flowers at the rim. Finally, there is a line of raised, white, shell-edge decoration at the outer edge of the rim. A small amount of the hand-painted enamel has flaked off, most notably where the enamel is thickest.
