

## **Title Plate**

Date about 1830-1850

Primary Maker Smith Pottery

Medium Drape-molded redware with slip decoration and a lead glaze

Description Round redware plate with slip decoration beneath a lead glaze. The

plate was formed by trailing a line of white slip over the clay to form two

undulating lines with a single, curling line in between. Then, the clay was draped

over a rounded mold to give it its shape, before tooling the edge with a roulette

wheel. The top surface of the plate is glazed, which gives the white slip a yellow

appearance; the bottom is left unglazed. The plate shows moderate wear,

## Basic Detail Report mostly to the glaze in the center. The glaze has light scratches and wear in the

center, and light crazing on all other areas of the plate.
