## **Basic Detail Report**

Date late 19th century

Primary Maker Southmayd & Boardman

Medium Mechanically-molded stoneware with a salt glaze and brown slip glaze Description Small stoneware bottle with a plain tapered rim, angular shoulder, cylindrical body, and flat bottom. The bottle is glazed on the outside with a salt glaze, and on the interior with a brown slip glaze, or Albany-type glaze. To one side, beneath the shoulder, is the impressed retailer's mark, "SOUTHMAYD/ &/ BOARDMANS/ JAPAN BLACKING". There are several imperfections in the surface of the bottle, especially in the glaze immediately below the mark. There is one small chip in the rim.
