Title Jar Fragment

Date early-mid 19th century

Primary Maker Leffingwell family

Medium Wheel-thrown stoneware with a salt glaze and brown slip glaze

Description Triangular fragment of grey stoneware with a salt glaze on the exterior and a brown slip glaze, or Albany-type glaze, on the interior. The salt

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glaze exterior has a green tint, and there is a chip in the brown slip glaze. The

exterior of the fragment has raised and impressed lines; the fragment is from the

rim of an ovoid or cylindrical jar.
