

## **Title Pipe**

Date mid 19th century

Primary Maker Seth Goodwin

Medium Mold-formed redware with a brown slip glaze

Description Heavy, thick, redware pipe with a hollow, cylindrical center and tapered, exterior form. At the widest end of the pipe, the cylindrical, hollow area is widened to accommodate the narrow end of another length of pipe. The interior of the pipe is glaze with a brown slip glaze, or Albany-type glaze. The exterior of the pipe is not glazed, but is an uneven red color. An unknown white substance has adhered in an irregular pattern to the exterior of the pipe.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x diameter): 15 1/2 x 4 1/8in. (39.4 x 10.5 cm)
