Medium Wheel-thrown stoneware with a matte purple glaze

Basic Detail Report

Description Baluster-shaped stoneware pitcher with a solid matte purple, or lavender, glaze. The pitcher has a slightly flared rim with a short spout to one side, a narrower neck, globular lower half, and flat bottom. A pulled, loop handle is applied opposite the spout, connecting the rim and widest part of the pitcher. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width including handle x depth): $6.5/8 \times 6 \times 4.1/4$ in. $(16.8 \times 15.2 \times 10.8$ cm)
