## **Title Child's Bread-and-Butter Plate**

Date about 1840-1850

Primary Maker William Adams & Sons

Medium Mechanically-molded ironstone

Description Small, round, ironstone bread-and-butter plate. The plate is decorated at the ribbed rim with four medium-blue sprig-molded designs, alternating between between two vines twisted together with clusters of grapes and a single vine with cluster of grapes. There is a crack in the ironstone running

from the rim toward the center of the plate. All of the glazed surfaces are crazing, and there is a light brown discoloration on portions of the top and bottom of the plate.
