Description Sculpture made of solid pink or reddish-brown "cast stone," an artificial stone material composed of lime and a polyester binder, that was cast in a mold. The abstract, elongated sculpture shows a hooded figure with a slightly bowed head holding a baby in her arms. A hood or halo surrounds the head of the baby. The surface of the sculpture is smooth but pitted; the bottom of the sculpture is flat. A tape label is adhered to the outside of the sculpture, near the bottom. "Mary \$400.00/ LUMAN P. KELSEY" is hand-written on the tape in pencil.
