## Title Saucers

Date about 1933

Primary Maker Manning Bowman Company

Medium Cast porcelain with an opaque green glaze and silver luster decoration

Description Group of six porcelain saucers, part of a matching set of a percolating coffeepot (.1a-.1f), coffee cups (.2a-.7a), and saucers (.2b-.7b). The style of the set reflects the Art Deco and streamlined styles popular during the 1920s and 1930s. The saucers are made of white porcelain, with an opaque lime green glaze applied to the rim, but not the center, of each saucer. A line of silver luster has been applied to the inside and outside edge of the rim on each saucer.

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Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x diameter of each saucer): 1 x 3 3/4in.
