

Title Wine Glass

Basic Detail Report

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Blown and cut colorless lead glass

Description Wine glass made of blown and cut colorless lead glass. The wine glass has a plain rim, a slightly tapered body with a light pattern of vertical ribbing, an inverted baluster-shaped stem containing an inverted, elongated tear-shaped air bubble, and a round foot. Cut decoration of the wine glass begins with a row of slender, vertical ovals in the middle of the hollow portion, above six short flutes. Just below this, the stem has been cut to a hexagonal shape. There are a small number of minor chips or flakes to some of the sharply cut edges.
