Basic Detail Report

Description Wine glass made of blown colorless lead glass. The wine glass has a plain rim, tapered sides and stem, and a round foot with a folded edge and a pontil mark on the bottom. Pontil mark: A rough place on a blown glass object where the solid metal rod, or pontil, is cracked off the object after final shaping and decoration. Pontil marks can be polished to achieve a smooth surface.
