

Title Fly Trap with Stopper

Date 1875-1900

Primary Maker Chase family

Medium Free-blown colorless non-lead glass

Basic Detail Report

Description Free-blown colorless glass fly trap and stopper. The fly trap (.b) has a ring at the rim with a ground top edge, a short cylindrical neck, and a globular body that sits on three tooled feet. The bottom of the fly trap curves up inside the body and forms a plain, round rim surrounded by a ring-shaped trough. The fly trap is accompanied by a pressed stopper (.a). The stopper consists of a spherical finial over a disc, above a cylindrical portion that fits loosely into the neck of the fly trap.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height including stopper x diameter): $8\ 1/2\ x$ 6in. (21.6 x 15.2cm)
