Medium Blown colorless lead glass with a light green tint

## **Basic Detail Report**

Description Wine glass made of blown colorless lead glass with a light green tint.

The wine glass has a plain rim, tapered sides and stem, a small ring, or knop, at the base of the stem, a round foot with a folded-under edge, and a shallow kick and a pontil mark on the bottom. There are a few light scratches on the exterior of the glass, but not on the bottom of the foot. Kick: An indentation in the bottom of a drinking glass, bottle, or other glass object. Pontil mark: A rough place on a blown glass object where the solid metal rod, or pontil, is cracked off the object after final shaping and decoration. Pontil marks can be polished to achieve a smooth surface.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x diameter): 4 1/8 x 2 1/4in. (10.5 x 5.7 cm)
