

# Basic Detail Report



## Title Decanter

Date 1815-1840

Primary Maker Katherine Cole

Medium Blown three-mold colorless lead glass

Description Small, blown three-mold colorless lead glass decanter with a flared lip, an inverted conical neck, a low sloping shoulder, a semi-barrel-shaped body,

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and a shallow kick with a pontil mark on the bottom. Two rings circle the neck of the decanter, each consisting of a double band of glass decorated with vertical tool marks. A raised geometric pattern decorates the sides of the decanter. This pattern consists of a band of vertical ribbing at the shoulder, a band of diamond diapering at the widest point of the decanter, and a second band of vertical ribbing circling the lower sides of the decanter. A pattern of elongated diamonds circle the pontil mark on the bottom of the decanter. The inside of the neck is ground to receive a stopper (now missing). The bottom of the decanter has light scratches and wear. A large portion of the lip and upper neck (.b) has broken off of the decanter.
