

Title Mugs

Date about 1795-1800

Primary Maker Edward Danforth

Medium Cast pewter

Description Pair of cast pewter mugs, each with a cylindrical body with straight, tapered sides. Each mug has a solid, cast handle that is soldered onto the body; the S-curve handle is flat on the top, rounded on the inside, and has a rounded terminal at the bottom. Each mug has two plain, narrow bands: one at the rim and another three-quarters down the body. Each mug has tapered molding

around the base and has a flat bottom. Both mugs have overall light scratches and nicks. Both have been polished and had larger dents removed. Mug .1: The interior and underside have visible skimming marks and chatter marks. The terminal has visible finishing marks. The outermost point of the handle has one wide dent. Mug .2: The outermost point of the handle has several small dents. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width including handle x depth at base of mug .1): $6 \times 7 \times 4 \text{ 3/4in}$. (15.2 x 17.8 x 12.1cm) Primary Dimensions (height x width including handle x depth at base of mug .2): $5 \cdot 15/16 \times 7 \times 5 \text{ in}$. (15.1 x 17.8 x 12.7cm)
