## Title Plate

Date 1760-1770

Primary Maker Thomas Danforth II

Medium Cast pewter

Description Cast pewter plate with a 1 1/4-inch-wide plain rim, a shallow well, and an incised line circling the bottom of the well. The booge, or sides of the well, is hammered. There are light scratches over all the surfaces of the plate.

Museum wax is adhered to the top surface of the well.
