

## **Title Patens**

Date 1810-1820

Primary Maker Thomas Danforth Boardman and Sherman Boardman
Medium Cast pewter

Description Pair of cast pewter patens, or dishes, part of a Communion service consisting of a pair of Communion cups (.1-.2), a pair of patens (.3-.4), and a flagon (.5). Each paten has a single bead at the outer edge of the 1 3/16-inchwide rim, a relatively deep well, and a faint incised line circling the bottom of the well. The top of paten .3 has light scratches; the underside is lightly scratched and worn. Paten .4 has light scratches over all surfaces, with two additional areas of deeper scratches on the top surface of the well. Paten .4 has a general pattern of wear on the underside of the well.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x diameter at rim of each paten):  $15/8 \times 111/8$  in.  $(4.1 \times 28.3 \text{cm})$
