Title Vacuum Bottle

Date about 1930s

Primary Maker The American Thermos Bottle Co.

Medium Chrome, painted with black enamel, with a glass interior liner and a (probably) black-painted wooden head on the stopper

Description Spherical vacuum bottle (.a) with a flattened, curved handle that runs from the middle back of the bottle to the top front. The front of the handle adjoins a shallow circular opening with a curved lip at the front. The stopper (.b) fits inside this opening. The stopper has a round head, probably made of black-painted wood, attached to a narrower cylindrical portion that fits inside the opening in the bottle. The vacuum bottle has a shallow foot at the bottom. The top half of the vacuum bottle and the handle, including the lip on the opening of the bottle, are chromium-plated steel. The bottom half of the vacuum bottle and the rounded head of the stopper are painted with black enamel. The bottle has a glass liner.
