The wooden crate is branded with the following: "TRADE MARK 'TWOPLEX' REGISTERED /1905 /BOXED /DEMIJOHN /MADE UNDER THE PATENTS OF GEO. W. BANKER /FRED C. WHITE /241 WATER ST. NEW YORK."
