

## **Title Swiss Flag**

Date 1917-1918

Primary Maker George Wells Cheney Sr.

Medium Machine stitched; Plain woven wool

Description Flag representing Switzerland consisting of a white cross in the center of a red field. The flag is a single piece of wool dyed red with a white cross (+) centered in the middle. The top edged of the flag is a selvage edge while the other three edges are machine hemmed.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width): 22 1/4 x 28 1/4in. (56.5 x 71.8 cm)
