of the Undercliff Sanatorium. One postcard shows patients basket-weaving and

weaving on looms at Dr. Givens' Sanatorium in Stamford. A few cards do not

depict hospitals. They include the Atheneum and Morgan Memorial in Hartford;

two views of the Yale Campus; the residence of Dr. C.G. Kerley in Sharon; and St.

Andrew's [Church] in Stamford.
