

Title Travel Photograph Frame

Date 1886-1941

Medium Laquered brass and black and white photographs

Description Small portable hinged photograph frame designed for travel or to carry in one's handbag. The brushed brass finish is protected with a coat of lacquer and the initials "B.F.A." (for Beatrice Fox Auerbach) are engraved on the front of the frame; an engraved inscription on the back reads: "The Fifteen Club / 1886 - 1941." The frame holds two small copy prints of what would originally have been much larger photographs. The one on the left taken in 1886 shows 12 young women and a young girl in a white pinafore standing outdoors with a pagoda framework (for climbing roses?) as the backdrop. The image on the right

shows a group of 27 women seated at a large table set for a meal. This image

was taken about 1941.
