Description An automobile is on a snow-covered street. A woman stands on the street corner, and two men or boys are on the porch of a building at the intersection which may be either a house or a small store. Other houses or stores are at left and right. Piles of snow, leafless trees, and a fence line the street. Snow-covered hills are in the background.
