Description Interior and exterior views of the Vienna Bakery and adjoining businesses on Main Street, New Britain. Some photographs include employees, including Frank Guenther, Mr. Graff, James B. Grace, George Hodge, Jim Keogh, Jake Weher, Nan Gorman, Maud Manning, and Frank Guenther's wife and daughter, Hulda and Anna, and their dog Prince. Signs read "Gorman's / New York Art Store" "McCabe / Plumber" "Felt & Norton" "Hart's Bazaaar" "Vienna Bakery" "City / Bakery / Ice / Cream" Merchandise is displayed in store windows. In one photograph, small American flags are displayed in a store window. Many of the male employees have mustaches and wear aprons. Ovens, barrels, and cooking utensils are visible in the interior views.
