

Title Hinckley's Mill, Near Lebanon, Connecticut

Description A dilapidated wooden mill building is seen from the back. The building appears to be built into a hillside. Part of the first floor is open, supported on wooden posts, and part of the building has a foundation of large field stones. A brick or stone chimney is at the left and a metal stovepipe is at the right. The building is surrounded by small trees.
