## **Basic Detail Report**

Medium Photography; albumen prints on paper on cardboard mounts; collodion prints on paper on cardboard mounts; platinum prints on paper on cardboard mounts

Description Formal studio portraits of unknown men, women, a young girl, and an infant. The photographs were taken in Hartford, Middletown, New Britain, and New Haven. One woman is wearing a feather boa. One woman is wearing eyeglasses (a pince-nez) and holds a young baby. One woman wears an elaborate hat. One double portrait shows a man with a mustache and a woman wearing a cameo on the neck of her dress.
