what are presumably the Skinner gardens. Numerous photographs show views on Lake Pocotopaug, including Schoolhouse Bay and Lakeview Cemetery. One photograph shows what appears to be a summer cottage in the winter. Several photographs document the process of charcoal burning. Several photographs depict the aftermath of an ice storm. Two photographs show a Fourth of July parade in East Hampton. One photograph shows a railroad train on a trestle on the Airline Railroad.
