

Description Street map of Keney Park and the surrounding neighborhood in

Hartford, Connecticut, with the town line of Bloomfield to the north, Windsor

Avenue and the town line of Windsor to the east, Barbour Street to the south,

and Bluehills Avenue to the west. In the park, the West Meadow, Bushland, Ten

Mile Woods, Eliotdale, East Meadow and other areas and features are named.

Green is used to denote the park, and blue marks the locations of water,

including Gully Brook and two lakes or reservoirs. Dotted and broken lines are

used to denote roads and paths within the park.
