

Description Street map of Hartford, Connecticut, as it existed in 1788. The map is oriented north-south but is presented on the paper in the east-west direction, so that the Connecticut River is at the bottom of the page. The city extends from Soldier's Field in the north, the Connecticut River in the east, South Green in the south, and West Street in the west. A reference list below the title shows the residences and/or business locations of charter members of the Governor's Horse Guards, with corresponding numbers scattered throughout the map.
