Description Blueprint depicting the layout of Saybrook Point in 1647, including public spaces and plots of land with the owners' names. The public spaces include the meeting house yard, the green and the common. To the north is North Cove; the west, the Connecticut River; the south, South Cove; and the west, the gate. Along the southern edge of the peninsula is a marsh, and at the western tip is the fort.
