Sound, with latitude and longitude lines and coordinates. The legend provides information about the features found on the map. Color is used to denote built-up areas, state parks and state forests. Interstate highways, U.S. highways, state highways and other roads are marked with lines of varying widths, and the names of cities are sized according to population. Town names are also given, with broken lines separating towns and counties. The three bordering states, New York, Massachusetts and Rhode Island, are named on the map but no geographical or political features are given.
