

Description Map of New York, with Canada to the north; parts of New

Hampshire, Massachusetts and Connecticut to the east; the Atlantic Ocean and New Jersey to the south; and Pennsylvania, the "Six Nations Indian Country" and Lake Ontario to the west. Relief is conveyed through hachures. Various lines are used to denote county boundaries and real property. Some railroads or other transportation lines appear to be marked but not labeled. Physical features include mountains, conveyed through hachure marks; lakes; rivers; and waterfalls.
