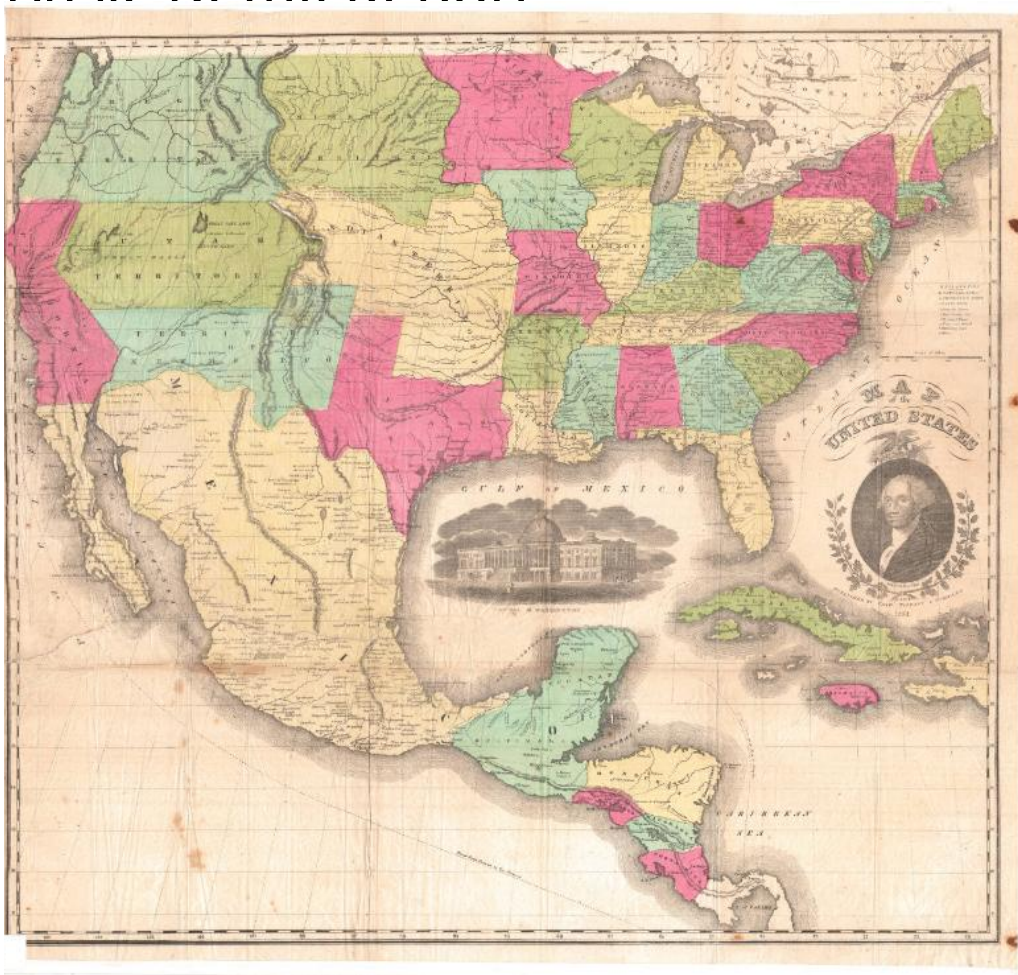

Description Map of the United States, Mexico, Central America, Cuba, Jamaica and Haiti, from the border of Canada to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the east, Panama to the south, and the Pacific Ocean to the west. The states and countries are colored green, blue, pink or yellow and are further defined by border lines. To the right of the map is an explanation of the symbols marking capital cities, "important" towns, large towns, smaller towns, missionary

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stations, court houses, forts, canals, military posts and mines. Elevation is

depicted by the use of hachure marks. Two routes are marked, that from New

York to Chagres, and that from Panama to San Francisco. The cartouche

contains a portrait of George Washington below an eagle holding an olive

branch, arrows and a seal featuring the flag of the United States. Below the

portrait of Washington are two oak branches laden with acorns. In the Gulf of

Mexico area of the map is a vignette of the United States Capitol.
