Description Manuscript map of Unionville, in the town of Plainfield, Connecticut, extending from the Hartford, Providence and Fishkill Railroad and Gladding's Mill to the north, the Union Ville Company's pond to the east, and the Moosup River to the south and west. The map details the Plainfield Union Company's property on the Moosup River, including its mills and other buildings, headrace and tailrace, pond, and houses. Lines of latitude and longitude are penciled in on all four sides. At the top, there is an inset of Union Pond, the Head Race, and the West End Tail Race, and to the right of the map is an eight-point compass and north arrow.
