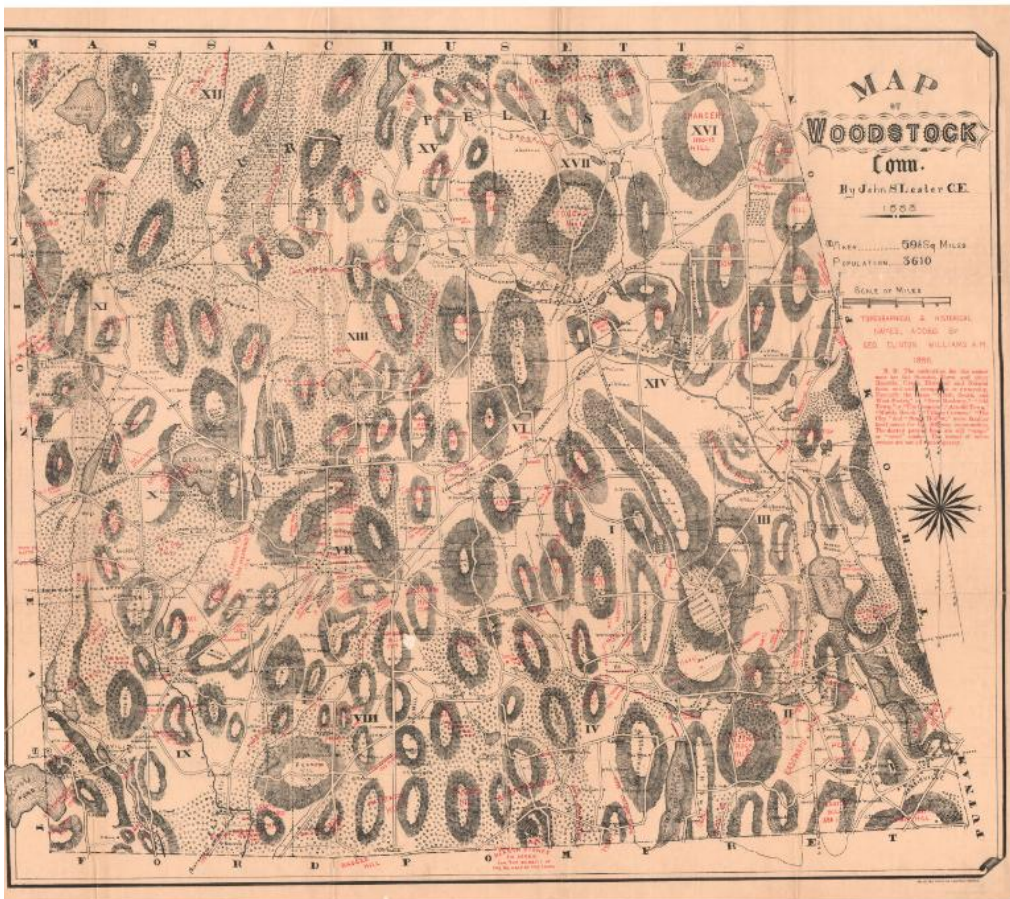

Description Map of Woodstock, Connecticut, from the border of Massachusetts

to the north, Putnam and Thompson to the east, Eastford and Pomfret to the

south, and Union and Eastford to the west. The map primarily shows the local

hills, conveyed with hachure marks and labeled in red. Also in red are historical

names and dates related to buildings and landowners. The town is divided into

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seventeen sections, divided by broken solid lines. Roads are denoted with solid parallel lines and some of them are labeled. Buildings, probably mostly houses, are indicated with solid black squares and the owner's name if known.
