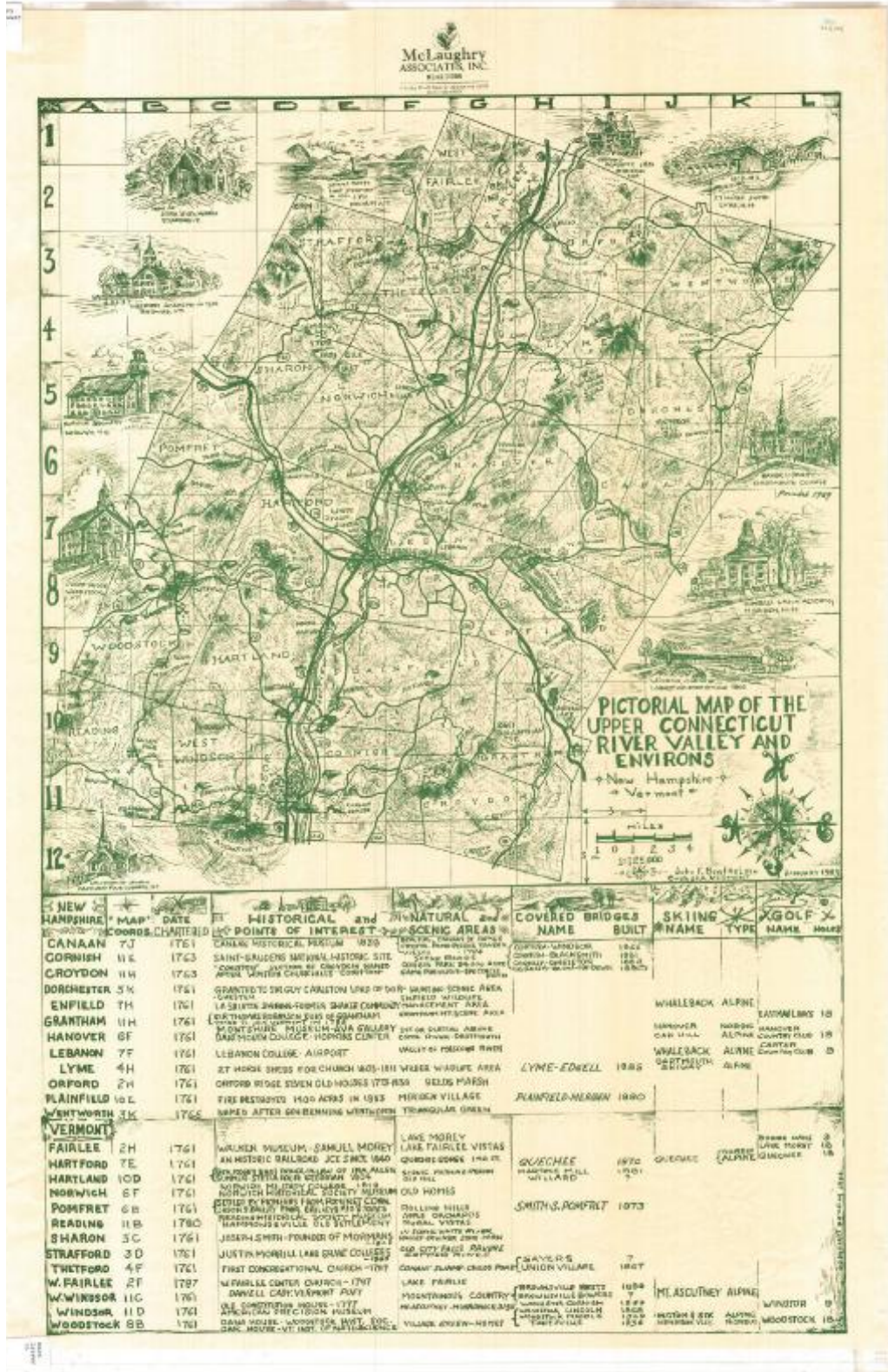

Description Pictorial map depicting the Connecticut River valley in Vermont and New Hampshire. On the map itself, there are small drawings that denote the locations of covered bridges, and symbols that represent ski areas and golf courses; while around the map are drawings that show churches, courthouses, private homes and academies. Elevation is conveyed through hachure marks. At the bottom is a list of towns on the map, their coordinates, date chartered, historical landmarks and points of interest, natural and scenic areas, covered bridges, and ski and golf areas.
