Description Map of Colchester, Connecticut and surroundings showing a proposed water distribution system with a pumping station to the north drawing on a wetland, a standpipe to the south on Dublin Hill, and water mains with gates and hydrants. The system serves the center of Colchester, including Pine Street, portions of North and South Main Street, Hayward Avenue, High

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Street, Mill Street, Park Street, and portions of Hall Hill Road and the Norwich

Turnpike. Also shown are the Hayward Rubber Company, Bacon Academy, a

hotel, the Post Office, Linwood Cemetery, and the Colchester branch of the New

York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad. Outlying roads and streams are not

named. An arrow indicates that the map is oriented with north towards the

lower right corner.
