Offwhite rubber electrical cord attaches to back, engraved across, "UL / HEY CO / MADE IN U.S.A.". Attached to bottom of base are four adjustable rubber pad feet. Center front of base has, "Stromberg," printed across in black; below this is an oval metal plaque, engraved across, "13512". Above base is a space separating it from the top; here a timecard would be inserted. Top of timeclock forms to a curve and is removable to reveal the inside of clock. Center of top has a glass covered analog clock, numbered 1-12 in black, with a metal border; printed across clock, "STROMBERG / MADE IN U.S.A.". Below clock is a red vertical line and on either side are two circular holes. Right side of top has a lock with a removable key. Brass key is attached to a rusted paper clip and round piece of paper with a thin metal border; engraved on one side of key, "CANADA / CGI"; engraved on opposite side, "GUILD / INDUSTRIES / Guild".
