Description Bust length miniature of a man facing center. He has grey eyes, black hair, and a beard; hair is combed back and styled upwards at top. He wears a black jacket with wide lapels, a white stock with a high collar and a black bow tie secured tightly under chin. Portrait is set in wooden frame, possibly mahogany, with a gold border around image. Nailed to verso of frame is a brown, heavy paper. Secured into backing are two brass suspension loops along with four stickers; the first, located at top is a white circle sticker with navy blue print that reads, "F.W. TIERNAN & CO /ART STORE /NEW HAVEN, C.T."; below this is a large off-white sticker with black print and handwritten ink that reads, "Portrait of Henry Albert Seymour /Born at New Hartford, Conn. /Died at Bristol /Conn.
