She wears a gold necklace tied tight to her neck, and a white shawl over a gray dress. The miniature is set in a square black wooden frame with a gold metal border around the portrait. The backing of the frame is a black paper board nailed to the wooden edges with a metal wire stretched across center and attached to suspension loops on sides;
