Description Map of the village of Wethersfield, Connecticut, depicting the mid-twentieth century appearance of the village, with the buildings and street system as they looked pre-1840. 116 buildings are shown and numbered, with each number corresponding to a list containing information about the original owner, date of construction, and the street on which the building was located.

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Natural features include the Wethersfield Cove and the Connecticut River, both depicted at the top. At the bottom is historical information about Wethersfield and descriptive information about the map.
