Description Map of the city and town of Hartford, Connecticut, oriented eastwest on the map with the Connecticut River at the bottom. The towns of

Bloomfield and Windsor form the boundary to the north, the river to the east,

Wethersfield (spelled "Weathersfield" on the map) to the south, and West

Hartford to the west. The city is divided into sections lettered from A to X, and
the town, divided from the city by the city line, is divided into two lettered
sections, AA and BB. Local roads are labeled, and cemeteries, hospitals, Trinity

College and Bushnell Park are colored green. The Connecticut Valley; New York
and New England; and New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroads run
through the city and town. On the right side of the map are three business
