The main body of the tablet reads as follows: "Judges Cave/ here May fifteenth 1661 and for some weeks/ thereafter Edward Whalley and his son-in-law/ William Goffe member of parliament general/ officers in the army of the commonwealth and/ signers of the death warrant of King Charles/ first found shelter and concealment form the / officers of the crown after the restoration. 'Opposition to tyrants is obedience to god'/ 1896"
