

New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad and the Air Line. Other railroads

include the Western Railroad; the New Haven-Springfield Line of the Hartford

and New Haven Railroad; the Stonington Railroad; the Providence Railroad; and

the Boston and Worcester Railroad.
