Railroads shown include the New York and New Haven; Naugatuck; New Haven and Northampton; and Hartford and Providence Railroads. Physical features include elevation, conveyed through hachure marks; rivers; and lakes. On the outside of the cover, the Connecticut state seal and motto are shown.
