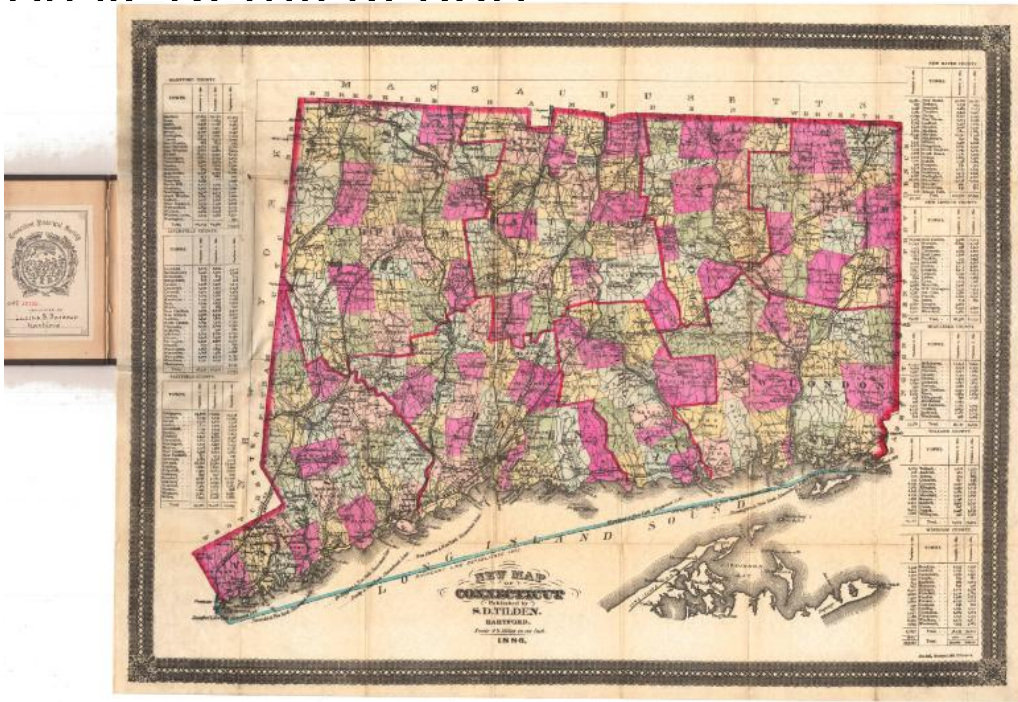

Description Pocket map of the state of Connecticut, with the border of Massachusetts to the north, the border of Rhode Island to the east, part of Long Island and the Long Island Sound to the south, and the border of New York State to the west. The state is divided into counties, outlined in red; and towns, colored green, blue, yellow or pink. The New York, New Haven and Hartford; Portchester and Ridgefield (unfinished); Danbury and Norwalk; Boston, Hartford and Erie; Housatonic; Shepaug; Hartford, Providence and Fishkill; Boston and New York Air Line; Shore Line; New York and New England; Norwich and Worcester; and the New London Northern Railroads lines are depicted. Around

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the edges of the map are tables for each county in the state, with the towns and their populations in 1860, 1870 and 1880 listed.
