Description Map of the Tunxis Trail system in Bristol, Connecticut, and the surrounding communities of Collinsville, Canton, Unionville, Farmington, Burlington, Harwinton, Plantsville, Plymouth, Terryville, and Wolcott. Parts of the Mattatuck, Metacomet, and Quannipiac Trails are also shown. Major features include the Nepaug Reservoir, Buttermilk Falls and other waterfalls, a fish hatchery, a coppermine, a log cabin, a quarry, an unconformity, the Devil's Kitchen, the Johnnycake Mountain Fire Tower, and Tories Den. Major state highways include Routes 10, 6, 177, 167, 101, and 117. Small cartoon figures include hikers, rock climbers, a man cooking over a campfire, and a woman wading in a pond.
