Description Pocket map of the state of New Hampshire, with part of Maine to the east, part of Massachusetts to the south, and part of Vermont to the west. The state is divided into counties, colored pink, blue, yellow, or peach, and is outlined in pink. The Portland Branch of the Grand Trunk; Vermont Central; Montreal; White Mountain; Concord and Claremont; Cheshire; Portsmouth and Concord; Boston and Maine; Nashua and Wilton; and Manchester and Lawrence Railroad lines are all shown. Local roads are depicted too, but are not labeled. Physical features include elevation, conveyed through hachure marks; rivers; and lakes.
