

Title Interior of a Cellar or a Passageway

Medium Photography; gelatin emulsion on glass

Description Brick piers extend upward from ground level to a ceiling in the interior of what is probably a cellar. Wooden partitions between the supports divide the space into what may be separate storage areas. A puddle of water at the left may be leakage from a pipe that runs from floor to ceiling.
